


# Parent Child Program




Therefore, keeping the legacy of Harold Keltner and Joe Friday always in mind, we present...




Explanation of the Program Compass

• The spirit of the program is experienced through belonging to a small **Community** 


• Fun is the Magic of the Program

Slogan: "Friends Forever"


#### Aims:

•Maintains <u>strong emphasis</u> on parent and child doing activities TOGETHER in a small group community


•Introduces and welcomes FAMILY participation

•Allows the local Y the creativity to expand the MAGIC!


The program has the following additional elements:
